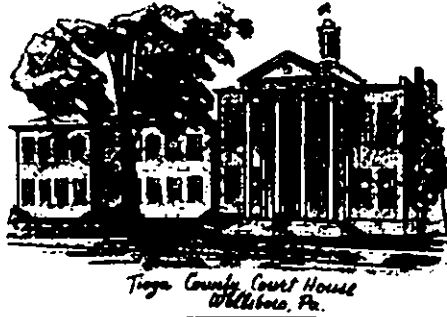

Dear Ms. Bose,

We are in receipt of the Notice of Intent for Dominion Transmission, Inc. proposed Storage Factory Project dated January 24, 2008. It is confusing to us that the Middletown Compression Station listed is part of the Salt Storage Project in Tioga Co. What is the connection and with a distance of over 200 miles why would these two projects be lumped together for review? Especially across state lines?

In addition, in a letter dated September 24, 2007 the Tioga Co. Planning Commission provided comment on the proposed storage project here in Tioga Co. PA and listed impacts to drinking water wells as a serious environmental concern. In reviewing your current list of Currently Identified Environmental Issues on page 5 of the NOI this concern is not listed. As the local government agency with responsibility for the approval of Land Development in Tioga Co. it is our intent to ensure the protection of the public and our natural resources. Upon review and comparison of the initial project scope and the way it is now presented (based on map provided) the location of the Storage Caverns have been moved closer to the area where water wells already have problems with natural gas. Please contact me at your earliest convenience to address these issues.
