Dear President Gardner and Members of the Board of County Commissioners:

I am writing to respond to the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Frederick County, Maryland's February 19, 2008 letter concerning the above-referenced proposed natural gas compressor station.

DTI appreciates the Board's interest and input in this matter as well as the feedback received from the Frederick and Middletown communities. DTI takes the concerns of the Board and the community seriously and, as part of the pre-filing case before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"), DTI is performing a complete Storage Factory Project alternatives analysis. Through this analysis, DTI will investigate all reasonable and feasible technical and locational alternatives to the proposed natural gas compressor relay station on the Marker Road property. This investigation must necessarily be guided by engineering and feasibility factors but will also give due consideration to the historic, cultural and aesthetic concerns raised in the Board's letter and in feedback from the community. DTI expects to complete this investigation in April 2008.

On behalf of DTI, I thank the Board and the Frederick/Middletown communities for their participation in the FERC pre-filing review process and reiterate that DTI looks forward to working cooperatively to address the public energy needs and the concerns related to this proposal.
